Subject: Dredging of the Little Magothy River Channel

Dear Contractor

Little Magothy River Association (LMRA) is seeking bids for the dredging of the Entrance channel into the Little Magothy River. The Little Magothy River Association hired Bay land Inc. to obtain the necessary permits to facilitate the dredging. LMRA has received the necessary permits and collected funding thru our special residence tax district. Because the dredging fund is 100% privately funded, we are looking at every option possible to remove as much material possible at the best price. The permit now states the dredged material will be placed at the Crandell DMP site. We are soliciting for alternative options that provide for reuse of the material which will reduce our cost per yd. The material to be dredged is beach quality sand, suitable for coastal placement.

Interested bidders should provide LMRA with description of any alternative material placement sites and the total price \$ per yd. and guaranteed quantity at the proposed rate, not to exceed 1,000cuyds.

Interested bidders may request copy of the permit, material sample and arrange site visit.

# LMRA Little Magothy River Association

## Major specifications are:

- Total Permitted length app. 1,731'
- Width between 50' to 65' depending on channel segment location
- Dredging Depth of maximum 6' Mean low Water (MLW)
- Volume estimate of 1,000cubic yards sand FY 2013/14
- LMRA will provide proposed dredging plan indicating exact locations.
- Dredging Window – Outer channel 10/15-12/15
  - Inside Bulkhead and inner channel 10/15-2/15
- Material is average 49% medium 50%fine with less than 1% silt
- Approved for disposal at Crandell Dredge material Placement Site
- Material can be either hydraulically or mechanically dredged

Permit states that dredged material to be placed at Crandell DMP site, we encourage bidders to seek alternative options for legal material placement that will have provide favorable cost per cubic yardage. LMRA revise the permit to include alternative placement sites. Proposals for single task order or multi-year contract will be considered.
